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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 7th Engineer Battalion continued support of the III Marine Amphibious Force within the Da Nang area. Platoons from the attached 1st and 3rd Bridge Companies are rendering additional support in the Chu Lai, Hue/Thu Bai, and Dong Ha areas.

Company "B", 9th Engineer Battalion continued engineering operations on Route 1 between Danang and Thang Binh to upgrade Highway 1 for class 50 traffic inspite of intensive enemy sabotage.

Company "B", 9th Engineer Battalion continued general support of the Army at Hill 63.

Company "B", 9th Engineer Battalion completed re-decking of the old Song Cau Lau Bridge at BT 091553.

Company "B", 7th Engineer Battalion completed approaches to the Ha Dong Bridge.

Company "B", 7th Engineer Battalion completed repairs of the Cooper Bridge at AT 031648 of pile bent design.

Company "C", 7th Engineer Battalion completed treadway and curb on the Ha Dong Bridge.

Company "C", 7th Engineer Battalion continued upgrading of Route 5 from BT 946701 to AT 912743.

1st Bridge Company, 7th Engineer Battalion removed a 120' M-6 Bridge at BT 225347.

- 4 Four Homelite Chain Saws were received from the Force Engineer, III MAF. Three were sent as instructed to the 11th Engineer Battalion. One was assigned to Company "B", 7th Engineer Battalion for use and evaluation.
- 7 A team from FSR arrived to make modifications to the M51A2 fuel system.
- 11 One M-49 refueling tanker was received from 1st Shore Party Battalion to fill a T/E deficiency in Service Company.
- 15 Eight M4T6 pontoons were picked up by 1st Bridge Company from ARVN I Corps Engineers, DaNang. The pontoons were used at the Song Cau Do River. The pontoons were received on a temporary loan of thirty days.
- 18 A request was submitted to Commanding General, 1st Marine Division to be permitted to construct a new Industrial Relations building which would be constructed as part of a gate facility.
- The first of seventy five bundles of M8A1 matting were picked up at M8A and delivered to Company "D". The matting will be used in the construction of a helopad at Hill 37.
- 19 Captain JONES, the Division Surgeon visited the Battalion Aid Station to inspect the facilities and operations.
- 20 A request for the assignment of USMC numbers to air compressors and track drills held by this Battalion was submitted to GMC.
- 22 Four D-6 tractors were available to be picked up by this Battalion as directed by the Force Engineer. The tractors were not accepted due to the number of mechanical discrepancies on the tractors.
- 28 Embarked and moved 5 Eimco tractors and 6 operators to 11th Engineer Battalion.
- 30 Redistribution of M51A2 dump truck assets to allow more efficient usage of trucks. Three each to "A", "B", and "C" Companies, 10 to "D" Company with remainder in Service Company.

(2) Supply

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7th Engineer Battalion FNF (AG 21300)

During the month of December the Battalion Supply Section processed 268 priority 02 and 129 priority 05 requisitions and 519 priority 12 and 17 requisitions. Also processed were 714 receipts from due, 617 issues from due and 76 issues from warehouse.

1st Bridge Company FNF (AG 21325)

During the month of December 1st Bridge Company Supply Section processed 317 requisitions. Also processed were 212 receipts from due, 183 issues from due and 65 issues from warehouse.

3rd Bridge Company (AG 21335)

During the month of December 3rd Bridge Company Supply Section processed 130 requisitions. Also processed were 25 receipts from due, 23 issues from due, and 58 issues from warehouse.

(3) Motor Transport

Approximately 163,686 miles were logged on the Battalion's Motor Transport Vehicles during December.

(4) Maintenance

The Battalion Maintenance Platoon completed 70 Motor Transport work orders during the month of December. A total of 54 work orders were submitted, 16 were sent Maint Bn. Total work orders for Engineer Equipment numbered 127 with 104 completed and 13 were sent to FSR.

(5) Messing

The Battalion Mess Staff continued to provide four meals daily except on Sunday; the fourth meal being a midnight ration for night crews. On Sunday a brunch replaces breakfast and dinner.

(6) Medical

The Battalion Aid station treated 589 Military and 259 Vietnamese. During the month of December the Dental Clinic treated 154 Military and 1 Vietnamese.
