PART II

1. Narrative Summary

The 7th Engineer Battalion (Rein) continued support of the III Marine Amphibious Force throughout I Corps Tactical Zone with primary effort

concentrated in the Danang area.

Significant accomplishments during January include completion of a 317 ft. class 4 non-standard light vehicle bridge through a destroyed railroad bridge on Route 1c; installation of a 351 ft class 23 M4 floating bridge (w/1 M4T6 fleat) on Route 1c; completion of a 48 ft class 60 pile bent bridge on the Airborne Trail off of Route 5; completion of a 112 ft class 60 pile bent bridge on Route 5 South of Danang; reshaping and surfacing with 6" rock 1.0 km of road to hill 244 West of Danang; construction of 0.8km of road upon railroad bed from Ha Dong to Anderson Trail; and completion of plans for three more pile bent bridges, a road/bridge bypassing the village of Dai Loc on Route 5, and reopening Route 5 to An Hoa.

Other significant events include receipt of the first increment of multifuel dump trucks; dedication of a new 6 room brick school house completed as a joint Vietnamese/American project in Hoa Khanh village; and completion of a 1000 inch rifle range in the 7th Engineer Battalion area.

With the addition of Route 5 to An Hoa the 7th Engineer Battalion is now responsible for maintaining and upgrading approximately 121 km of roads. (See tab C to enclosure (1)).

- (b) On 14Jan67 a 351' class 23 M4 floating bridge with one M4T6 float was completed at Ha Dong on Route 1c at AT 989641.

- (f) On 31Jan67 completed construction of 9.8 km of road upon the old railroad bed (Route lc) from Ha Dong (AT 990641) to Anderson Trail (AT 993633).

- (1) Command Indoctrination and information continues for newly arrived personnel and debriefing for those departing.
- (2) 66 personnel attended the 1st Engineer Bn Land Mine Warfare School.
- (3) 170 personnel fired individual weapons for familiarization at the Battalion new 1000 inch range.
- (4) One Marine attended formal crypto comm security school.
- (5) Three personnel attended formal ADM school: All three were initial training.
- (6) One Marine Attended formal Vietnamese Language school.
- f. Logistics, Equipment, and Supply

(1) Administration

- (a) On 3 January a contact team from FLSG-"A" Maintenance came aboard to work on generators and recfers.
- (b) On 3 January a decontamination unit inteded for use at the vehicle washing facility arrived.
- (c) On 4 January a Quarterly Vehicle Status Report was submitted to Commanding General, 1st Marine Division.
- (d) On 10 January a request for real estate was submitted to ComNavFor Vietnam. The real estate requested was required for building and upgrading roads in Da Nang TAOR.
- (e) On 13 January a Special Allowance for Communication Electronics equipment was requested from Commanding General, lst Marine Division.
- (f) On 18 January a report of 7th Engineer Battalion motor transport and engineer equipment lost to enemy action was forwarded to the Engineer Officer, III Marine Amphibious Force.
- (g) On 27 January a request for 30 tropical huts was forwarded to Commanding General, 1st Marine Division. The majority of these huts were intended for billeting.
- (h) On 30 January L. T. I.s and acceptance checks were started on the first of eighty four M51A2 dump trucks to be received by this Battalian.

(2) Supply

(a) 7th Engineer Battalion FMF (RUC 21300). During the month of January the Battalion Supply Section processed 135 priority 02 and 05 requisitions and 2596 priority 12 and 17 requisitions. Also processed were 1920 receipts from due, 1742 issues from due and 447 issues from warehouse.

(b) 1st Bridge Company FMF (RU321325). During the month of January 1st Bridge Company Supply Section processed 297 requisitions. Also processed were 287 receipts from due, 154 issues from due and 52 issues from warehouse.

(3) Motor Transport. Approximately 111,628 miles were logged on the Battalion's Motor Transport vehicles during January.

- (4) <u>Maintenance</u>. The Battalion Maintenance Platoon completed 124 Motor Transport work orders during the month of January. A total of 154 work orders were submitted, 47 were sent to FLSG-1A³. Total work orders for Engineer Equipment numbered 80 with 70 completed and 4 were sent to FLSGO"A".
- (5) Messing. The Battalion Mess Staff continued the normal mess operation of providing four (4) meals daily except on Sunday; the fourth meal being a midnight ration for night crews. On Sunday a brunch replaces breakfast and dinner. Closer control of mess operations was sided by issuing regular, early, and late chow passes to members of this Battalion.

(6) Medical. The Battalion Aid Station treated 935 military and 5 Vietnamese. During the month of January the Dental Clinic treated 309 military and 15 Vietnamese.

(7) Embarkation. During the reporting period the following was manifested for surface shipping:

g. Civil Affairs/Civic Action

(1) The civil affairs program continues on a daily basis.

(2) Activities were as follows:

- (a) MEDCAP program provided treatment to 471 persons.
- (b) The Battalion sponsored, Vietnamese brickyard produced a total of 8,365 soil bricks.
- (c) A total of 429 bars of scap were distributed.
- (d) Three (3) truck loads of lumber were delivered to CHOM TAN Hamlet, one (1) load to PHUOC QUANG Hamlet, and one (1) load to DA PHUOC Hamlet.
- (c) On 7January 1967 the HOA KHANN Village School was dedicated by Major General Herman NICKERSON. Also present were Brigadier General Herman E. HERBOLD, local area Coordinators and the G-5 officers of III MAF, 1st Marine Division, and FLC. A representative of Mr. Girvin GRIFFITH, USAID Representative to QUANG NAM was also present. The guest speaker was Doctor J.W. ECHOLS, Assistant USAID Education Advisor to I Corps.
- (f) A request for seven thousand (7,000) bricks for a school building project in NAMO was submitted to the Civil Affairs Officer of 7th Engineer Battalion. Five thousand, one hundred and sixty-six(5,166) were taken with the remaining of the original seven thousand (7,000) requested to be picked up at the Red Beach Store House.


