NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 7th Engineer Battalion continued support of the III Marine Amphibious Force within the DaNang area. Platoons from the attached 1st and 3rd Bridge Companies are rendering additional support in the Chu Lai, Hue/Phu bai, and Dong Ha areas.

Company "A", 7th Engineer Battalion continues upgrading of Routes 33 and 30 for class 50 traffic. Also construction was started on the Ha Thanh Dam.

Company "B", 7th Engineer Battalion continued upgrading of Routes 1 and 12 for class 50 traffic. Construction was started on the Song Thanh Quit River Bridge.

Company "C", 7th Engineer Battalion continues upgrading of Route 5 north for class 50 traffic.

Company "D", 7th Engineer Battalion continued upgrading of Route 5 south for class 50 traffic.

2 April: Hauled, spread and compacted 426 cu.yds. of fill for upgrading Route 12 east, and spread 4,500 gallons of bunker oil on road. Hauled, spread and compacted 485 cu. yds. of fill on Route 5 between Hill 37 and ferry site. Removed a 231' M.T.6 floating bridge at YD 735234. Hauled, spread and compacted 2,210 cu.yds. of fill for Ammunition Storage area at the DaNang Airbase.

3 April: Hauled, spread and compacted 415 cu.yds. of fill between Hill 37 and ferry site on Route 5. Hauled, spread and compacted 624 cu.yds. of fill on Route 12 east. Emplaced 2,030 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

4 April: Hauled, spread, compacted and graded 1,120 cu.yds. of fill on Anderson Trail. Hauled, spread and compacted 300 cu.yds. of fill on Route 5 between Hill 37 and ferry site. Emplaced 2,040 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

5 April: Hauled, spread and compacted 350 cu.yds. of fill between Hill 37 and the ferry site. Emplaced 300 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

6 April: Hauled, spread and compacted 360 cu.yds. of fill on Route 1 south. Graded 2,000 meters of Route 12. Hauled, spread, compacted and graded 375 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Spread 1,200 gallons of bunker oil on Route 33. Emplaced 450 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

7 April: RMK installed (1) 36"X32' culvert in the Battalion CP area. Completed installation of (4) four 24"X100' drainage culverts at Ammunition storage area DaNang Airbase.

8 April: Hauled, spread, compacted and graded 550 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Completed wing walls and headwalls on culvert causeway at AT 946706. Checked all bridging on Route 1 from the Song Cau Do to the Song Cau Lau. Emplaced 2,000 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

9 April: Placed 210 cu.yds. of fill on by-pass, Route 1 south. Checked all bridges between the Song Cau Do and the Song Cau Lau bridge on Route 1. Emplaced 1,670 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

16 April: Placed 384 cu.yds. of fill and 50 cu.yds. of shot rock on by-pass at Dien Ban. Placed 235 cu.yds. of fill on Route 5 between Hill 37 and the ferry site. Completed work on abutment for bridge at AT 900805 on Route 33. Emplaced 690 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

17 April: Placed 225 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33, compacted and graded. Placed 664 cu.yds. of fill and 36 cu.yds. of shot rock on by-pass on Route 1 south at Dien Ban. Assisted Sea Bees at An Hoa with construction of an underground BAS. Emplaced 1,460 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

18 April: Placed 255 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Placed 564 cu.yds. of fill at the Dien Ban by-pass, compacted and graded. Completed 30' tower at CAP B-6. At 1700H an AirForce drone crashed at this CP at AT 937773, AirForce personnel removed all important equipment. Emplaced 1,070 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

19 April: Placed 435 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Placed 396 cu.yds. of fill on by-pass at Dien Ban, Route 1 south. Placed 180 cu.yds. of crushed rock on Anderson Trail. Drove first pile for Song Thanh Quit pile bent bridge, all equipment up. Emplaced 1,200 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

20 April: Loaded 172 cu.yds. of fill for the 1st Engineer Battalion at Hill 55. Placed 330 cu.yds. of fill on by-pass at Dien Ban Route 5A. Repaired the Song Thanh Quit floating bridge by placing (1) one 50 ton transom trestle in the center of the bridge. Completed (1) one 4 hole head and (1) one 20'X28'X14' tool room for CAG-2. Emplaced 1,320 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

21 April: Assembled two (2) culverts 22'X36". Drove three (3) piles for an abutment on the Song Thanh Quit pile bent bridge.

22 April: Loaded 240 cu.yds. of fill for 1st Engr Bn. Placed 200 cu.yds. of fill on Route 5 south. Checked all tactical bridges on Route 1 from the Song Cau Do to the Song Cau Lau river. Installed a 60' fixed span on existing bridge at BT 102511, class 30/35, length 73'1/4". Contractor hauled 396 cu.yds. of rock to An Hoa, stockpiled. Emplaced 970 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

23 April: Loaded 372 cu.yds. of fill for 1st Engr Bn at Hill 55. Spread 12,000 gallons of water on Route 5 south. Placed 190 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Placed 12 cu.yds. of rock and 132 cu.yds. of fill on by-pass, Route 1 Dien Ban. Emplaced 1,170 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

24 April: Placed 245 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Placed 354 cu.yds. of fill on by-pass Route 1, Dien Ban. Loaded 306 cu.yds. of fill for 1st Engr Bn. from Hill 55 fill pit. Hauled 282 cu.yds. of crushed rock from RMK to Anderson Trail. Installed 40' of a 120' fixed span at BT 055592. Completed one 6X10 4 hole head and one (1) 6X50 fence. Emplaced 1,040 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

25 April: Placed 215 cu.yds. of fill on Route 33. Replaced the bridge on Route 5 by-pass at AT 948707. Completed installation of a 120' fixed span at BT 055592. Work on 2/27 Battalion messhall drainage is 28% complete. Completed Helo pad at 7th Bulk Fuel Co. Emplaced 1,020 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

26 April: Placed 300 cu.yds. of fill on Route 5 between Hill 37 and Liberty bridge. Placed 222 cu.yds. of fill on by-pass Route 1 north of Dien Ban. Placed 306 cu.yds. of crushed rock on Anderson Trail. Completed repairs of water tower at 7th Comm Bn messhall. Emplaced 1,640 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

27 April: Hauled 220 cu.yds. of fill from Hill 55 to the Ha Thanh Dam access road. Hauled 315 cu.yds. of fill to Route 5 south of Hill 37. Drove 5 piles, dumped 54 cu.yds. of fill, and 48 cu.yds. of crushed rock on Song Thanh Quit river bridge project. Project is 11% complete. Assisted 3/7 with generator problems.

28 April: Drove 2 piles and staged 5 piles at the Song Thanh Quit river bridge. Continued work on north and south abutments. Emplaced 1,800 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

29 April: Hauled 735 cu.yds. of fill to Ha Thanh Dam access road. Hauled, graded and compacted 285 cu.yds. of crushed rock to Anderson Trail. Graded Route 6 between AT 948707 and AT 978725. Emplaced 150 cu.yds. of fill at FOL storage area. Completed one (1) observation tower for CAP units. Emplaced 1,200 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

30 April: Hauled 350 cu.yds. of fill to by-pass at 32' bridge on Route 5 south at AT 924605. Hauled 480 cu.yds. of fill to access road at the Ha Thanh dam site. Redecked 50% of the bridge on Route 30 in 7th Engr Bn CP area. Installed 1" cable on north abutment, drove 2 piles on south abutment and placed sheathing on north abutment of the Song Thanh Quit river bridge. Emplaced 1,350 cu.yds. of fill at the berm job at the DaNang Airbase.

(2) Supply

7th Engineer Battalion FMF (AC 21300)

During the month of April the Battalion Supply Section processed 470 priority O2 and 481 priority O5 requisitions and 355

priority 12 and 17 requisitions. Also processed were 1,068 receipts from due, 659 issues from due and 152 issues from warehouse.

1st Bridge Company FMT (AC 21325)

During the month of April 1st Bridge Supply Section processed 496 requisitions. Also processed were 320 receipts from due, 292 issues from due and 28 issues from warehouse.

3rd Bridge Company (AC 21335)

During the month of April 3rd Bridge Supply Section processed 166 requisitions. Also processed were 0 receipts from due, 0 issues from due, and 0 issues from warehouse.

Motor Transport

Approximately 114,727 miles were logged on the Battalion's Motor Transport Vehicles during April.

Maintenance

The Battalion Maintenance Platoon completed 124 Motor Transport work orders during the month of April. A total of 171 work orders were submitted, 14 were sent to Maintenance Battalion. Total work orders for Engineer Equipment numbered 110 with 94 completed and 7 were sent to FSR.

Messing

The Battalion Mess Staff continued to provide four meals daily except on Sunday; the fourth meal being a midnight ration for night crews. On Sunday a brunch replaces breakfast and dinner.

Medical

The Battalion Aid Station treated 141 Military and 237 Vietnamese. During the month of April the Dental Clinic treated 359 Military and 11 Vietnamese.

g. Civil Affairs/Civic Action

(1) The civic action program continues on a daily basis.

(2) Activities were as follows:

(a) The MDECAP Program provided treatment for two hundred thirty seven (237) persons.

(b) The Battalion sponsored, Vietnamese brickyard produced a total of twenty six thousand five hundred and forty eight (26,548) soil bricks.

(c) A total of twenty five thousand nine hundred and ninety five (25,995) bricks were released from the Battalion sponsored brickyard during the month of April in support of various projects through out Quang Nam.

(d) Ten (10) scholarships were given to Vietnamese children demonstrating proven academic ability.

(e) Through the manufacture of concrete well rings in the Battalion sponsored brickyard, two new wells were completed by the local populace and three old wells improved to include the installation of two manual pumps on recently covered wells.

(f) Routine support was given small building projects through distribution of salvaged building materials.

(g) The Battalion assumed the responsibility for two new hamlets, An Ngai Dong and Tung Son in the village of Hoa Thanh and was relieved of its responsibility for the hamlet of Hung Phuoc in the village of Hoa Vinh.
