Company A (Rein), 7th Engineer Battalion continues to support the III Marine Amphibious Force in the Danang area. The company continued the maintenance on 34.2 miles of road. Additionally, the company is also assigned to support MCB-3 in the repair of LTL-4 East and mine sweep of LTL-4 East also provide engineer equipment. The mine sweep team found and destroyed six pieces of enemy ordnance.

Company A (Rein) carried the mine sweep responsibility for 5.1 miles of road on HL 545.

Also, during the upgrade of HL 540 we provided a demo team to destroy ordnance given to them by civilians from Phu Son villages #1 and #2, which totaled 110 pieces of ordnance.

Company A operated one water pions and produced 800,000 gallons of potable water.

Company A was assigned the responsibility of dismantling, packing, and shipping of 26 Butler buildings. This operation was started on 3 February 1971 and sixteen buildings have been dismantled, and fifteen have been shipped.

Company A continued the acquisition and issue and control of TSFC materials for III Marine Amphibious Force.

1. Personnel - Company A (Rein), 7th Engineer Battalion lost 74 enlisted men and one officer through accelerated rotation and gained 142 enlisted men and two officers through normal replacements. There was one man promoted to Sergeant, five to Lance Corporal, three to Private First Class.
2. Enemy, Weather, Terrain
- a. Enemy - The company mine sweep team found and destroyed 24 pieces of ordnance.
- b. Weather - There were two days of rain during the month. This did not hamper road construction or maintenance.
3. Logistics - Company Supply has processed 113 new documents with 14 being received, 13 cancelled and 86 placed on back order. Out of the 361 old documents 9 old documents were completed and 319 old documents were cancelled. There are 4 02 priority documents over 30 days old, and 119 documents on back order. 44 items were Direct Exchanged, 38 were filled and 9 old Direct Exchange items were completed. There is a total of 35 Direct Exchange items still pending.

4. Motor Transport - A total of 47,171 miles were logged in by the company motor transport vehicles. There were 6,001 tons of earth products 199,000 gallons of non-potable water, and 20,000 gallons of oil hauled for road construction. There were 2,830 passengers transported and 1,430 tons of equipment and general cargo hauled.

5. Maintenance - The company maintenance platoon received 137 work orders of which 127 were completed. There were 38 work order opened at the beginning of the month and 16 of these were completed. There are 32 pending work orders, 2 of which are combat deadline awaiting parts, 12 are in higher echelon. There are 12 work orders awaiting parts which do not deadline the vehicle or equipment, 6 work orders are in the process of being worked on now.
